

Market update

Worldwide

A Peak Season Surcharge (PSS) has been introduced effective 1 August 2025, ranging from USD 300–500 per TEU, subject to carrier and trade lane.

China-Australia Lane

- Capacity has tightened as carriers reroute vessels to more profitable trades.
- Blank sailings have been introduced and are expected to continue throughout the 2025 peak season.
- With space decreasing and demand rising, we see rates are climbing again in July.
- Rate restorations were introduced on 1 July 2025, with some carriers planning further increases from 15 August 2025.
- FAK rates ex-China in 2nd half July around USD 2,500; expected to rise to **USD** 3,500 in August.

USA to Australia

- Rates have dropped significantly since mid-month, with 40ft containers starting from USD 1,650.
- August FAK rates estimated to increase to around USD 2,500 (including PSS)

SEA region


- Transhipment ports in the SEA region are expected to face growing backlogs in the coming months due to congestion; likely to experience shipping delays
- August rates from Malaysia and Indonesia are starting at approximately USD 1,600 per 40ft.

Europe to Australia

Rates are gradually declining, with average pricing now around USD 1,400 per 40ft container.

India

Freight rates have doubled since early 2025



Compliance Audit

By demonstrating a pro-active self-audit approach in a "Self-Assessment" environment to the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service (ACBPS).

This can reduce the frequency and intensity of customs checks and queries.



Duty Planning - Tariff Concession

Tariff Concession Order (TCO) reduces costs to the public by allowing duty-free entry for certain goods where there is no local industry that produces those goods.





Tradex and Duty Draw back Schemes

Imported goods to be re-exported

Upfront exemption from Import Tariff Duties & other taxes (GST) – Cash flow benefit

Duty Drawback

A government scheme that allows businesses to claim a refund of import duties paid on goods that are later exported, either in their original form or after being used in manufacturing
